महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषय पर भारत निर्वाचन आयोग के पत्र संख्या-56/Symbol/2024/PPS-II /VOL.IV दिनांक 28 फरवरी, 2024, तथा पत्र संख्या-56/Symbol/2024 /PPS-II /VOL.V दिनांक 29 फरवरी, 2024 का अवलोकन करने का कष्ट करें।

2- भारत निर्वाचन आयोग ने उक्त पत्रों द्वारा लोकसभा सामान्य निर्वाचन-2024 हेतु 11 रजिस्ट्रीकृत अमान्यता प्राप्त राजनैतिक दलों के उम्मीदवारों को निर्वाचन प्रतीक (आरक्षण तथा आवंटन) आदेश 1968 के पैरा 10बी के अन्तर्गत एकही प्रतीक (**Common Symbol**) आवंटित करने के सम्बन्ध में निर्देश जारी किये हैं। आयोग द्वारा उक्त 11 राजनैतिक दलों में से 01 राजनैतिक दल (**Bharat Jodo Party**) को उत्तर प्रदेश राज्य के 80 संसदीय निर्वाचन क्षेत्रों के लिए तथा 02 राजनैतिक दल (**Samajhdar Party & Swatantra Indian Labour Party**) को उत्तर प्रदेश राज्य के संसदीय निर्वाचन क्षेत्रों में एनेक्जर में दिये गये संख्या एवं निर्वाचन क्षेत्र के लिए एक समान प्रतीक (**Common symbol**) आवंटित किये गये हैं। इस प्रकार आयोग ने अब तक 42 राजनैतिक दलों में से 14 राजनैतिक दलों के उम्मीदवारों को उत्तर प्रदेश में एक समान प्रतीक देने के निर्देश दिये हैं।

3- आयोग ने यह भी निर्देश दिया है कि However, the said symbol shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in the constituencies where the aforesaid party does not actually set up its candidates.

The Returning Officers may be directed to allot the common symbol mentioned above to the candidates set up by the aforesaid registered un-recognized political parties, subject to fulfilment of the provisions of Para 13 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 relating to setting up of candidates by these parties. It may also be noted that said common symbols allotted to the candidates of the above-mentioned political parties, are not allotted by oversight to any other



candidates in these constituencies. However, the said symbol shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in the constituencies where the aforesaid party does not actually set up its candidates.

3. In the event of the above said parties failing to meet the requirement of the minimum number of candidates, as prescribed in Para 10B of the said Symbols Order, 1968, i.e., 5 % of total number of *Assembly Constituencies* and/or in minimum two (02) *Parliamentary constituencies* in the concerned State in case of Assembly election and/or Parliamentary election as the case may be, then the said common symbol shall not be available to their candidates.

4. It is hereby informed that the common symbol allotted to the respective party(s) is only for the forthcoming General Elections to the Legislative Assemblies or the Lok Sabha as mentioned in Table above. Further use of Common symbol by the respective party(s) is not allowed after the completion of the said election.
